



NCWVCAA Head Start/Early Head Start

**\*Do you have a child that is under the age of 5?**

**\*Are you expecting a child?**

**\*Do you live in Barbour, Marion, Pocahontas, Preston, Randolph, Taylor, Tucker, or Webster County and need early childhood services?**

**If you answered YES to any of these questions, you may be eligible for our Program!**

Head Start and Early Head Start is a national program that is federally funded and **FREE** to participate. Families who are income eligible or fall under the guidelines for Foster Care, Public Assistance, or are considered Homeless under the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act may be eligible.

Head Start offers services to children three to five years of age and children turning three within the school year. The Head Start Program prepares children for their next educational setting by strengthening social skills, learning, and development. Head Start classrooms are located in Barbour, Marion, Pocahontas, Preston, Randolph, Taylor, and Webster Counties.

Early Head Start is a **FREE** year round program that offers services to expectant families and families with children ages birth to three. The Early Head Start Program provides and supports comprehensive early childhood activities designed to foster healthy growth and development. Early Head Starts are located in Barbour, Marion, Randolph, Taylor, Tucker, and Webster Counties.
