* Weatherization aims to reduce the energy costs of low-income families, through energy-efficient weatherization measures.

* Weatherization specifically focuses on assisting low-income people; primarily the elderly, persons with disabilities, and families with children.

* High energy costs are an excessive burden on low-income families. Weatherization addresses this need for assistance.

* Heating programs are available alongside weatherization as well for emergency situations of no heat.

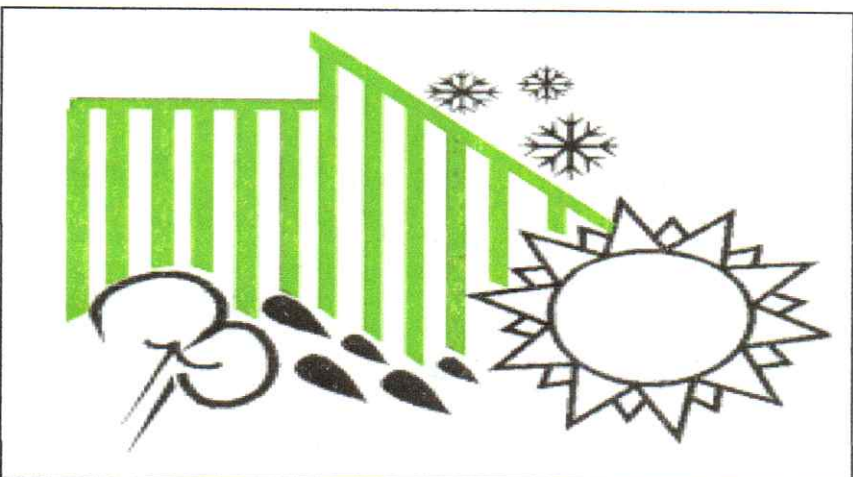

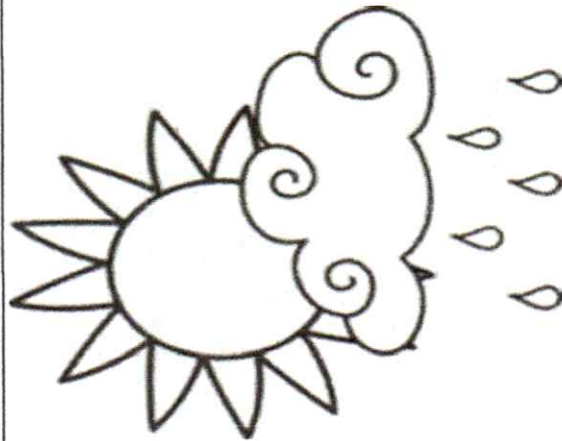

- Refrigerator testing (replacement under certain circumstance.)

To be eligible for the Weatherization Assistance Program, your dwelling unit must be structurally adaptable for weatherization materials, and the family income must be at or below 200% of the poverty guidelines. Households that receive SSI qualify for the program regardless of income.
